

Position Statement on Electronic Conveyancing Market Structures

ARNECC has agreed to undertake a project to compare the costs, risks and liabilities of various electronic conveyancing market structures. This work will be used to assist ARNECC members in providing advice to governments on the most appropriate future structure for electronic conveyancing in Australia. The work will build on all of the work that has already been undertaken and will identify the nature of modifications that would be required to the existing legislative framework.

This work will complement ARNECC's consideration of the recommendations from the independent review of the Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) for an Electronic Conveyancing National Law that was completed in December 2019 by Dench McClean Carlson.
